

Four Little Monkeys On Safari



Can you get four little monkeys in a row?

Object: To be the first one to get four monkeys (chips) in a row (on the game board).

Number of players: 2-3

Materials: Game board, 10-15 color chips or tokens per player that can be used to cover the squares on the game board, *No Peeking on Your Turn!* Multiplication reference chart, 3 number cubes

How to Play: Players roll two number cubes to determine who goes first. Multiply the number on each cube. The player with the highest product goes first. Play goes in a clockwise direction after the first player takes their turn.

Players take turns rolling 3 dice and finding the product of any 2 of the numbers on the dice. Cover that product on the game board with your chip. Once a player places a chip on the board, it cannot be removed by another player. Only one chip can occupy a space. The first person to cover 4 squares in a row (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally) with their chips wins! If a student questions whether his opponents did the multiplication correctly, he or she may refer to the multiplication reference chart.
