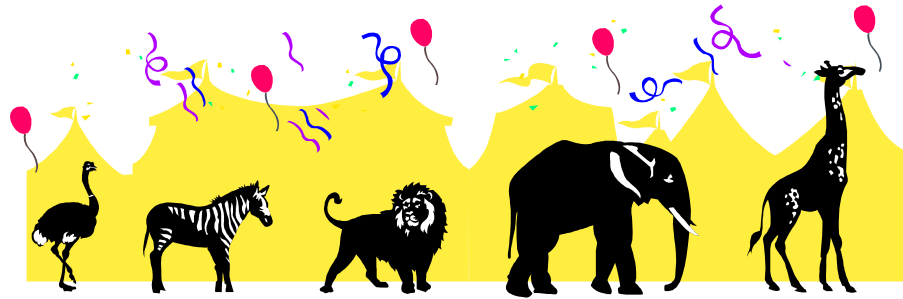


Multiplication M-A-T-H-O!



Can you be the first to get all five of your animals lined up?

Object: To be the first player to get five animals (chips) in a row on the M-A-T-H-O board.

Number of players: 4 - 40

Materials: Game boards (1 per player), 10-15 chips per player, a set of flash cards with multiplication facts (1-10), a pair of number cubes

How to Play: If playing in a small group, players roll the number cubes to determine who gets to be “caller” first. Multiply the number on each cube. The player with the highest product gets to be “caller.” If playing as a class, the teacher can determine who is caller by drawing names.

The caller calls out the multiplication equation. Any student may call out the answer (product). All players mark their game boards if they have the product. The student who gets 5 in a row (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally) first wins and gets to be the “caller” for the next game.
