When it comes to decorations before you buy anything you need to check the Ashmore Hall closet to see what we have left from last year. Mrs. Teresa has the key to the closet and will direct you in the right direction.

For Decorations:

- Plates
- Cups
- Table Covers (Last year we bought a white plastic giant roll which worked for us. It was affordable and easy clean up so I would recommend.)
- Forks
- Spoons
- Table skirts (which you can borrow from the president's office, all you need to do is call the secretary of his office and she will set you up for pick up.)

For Food:

- Ice
- You need to order your food and napkins from Chatnam Industries.

 - Maroon napkins with gold writing should be ordered at - (912) 644-7500 (If you would like an example of the napkins just look in the Ashmore Hall closet.)
- Chicken nuggets should be ordered from Chik-fil-a. Your order should not be placed the day before, make sure they have plenty of time to prepare the order.
- A sheet cake and spinach dip needs to be ordered from Publix.
 - Also at Publix we bought the Minute Maid Lemonade as our drink and put it in punch bowls (which we have two of them in the

closet) with slices of lemons. This worked well for us but we would also recommend have sugarless for the diabetics and also have Diet Coke available.
